

Eligibility based solely on type of Parole status granted (individual must also be an Illinois resident, meet income and age guidelines and other eligibility criteria). The information provided in the below chart assumes that the parole status is <u>active and not expired</u> and assumes that the individual has no other pathway to adjust status and is not also in the U.S. on an active nonimmigrant visa. ^{*}Individuals who have been granted parole for more than one year (after 8/22/96) but have had this designation less than 5 years AND individuals who have been granted parole for less than one year may also be eligible for VTTC, if they are preparing to file, or have filed an application for a U visa, T visa, or an application for asylum. Additionally, individuals who no longer have active Ukrainian Parolee status and individuals who no longer have active Afghan Parole status may be eligible for VTTC if they are preparing to file, or have filed an application for a U visa, T visa, or an application for asylum.

^{**}Individuals who no longer have active Venezuelan Parole status OR who are in their five year waiting period (have had parole for less than five years) may be eligible for VTTC if they can show that they are preparing to file, or have filed an application for a U visa, T visa, or an application for asylum.
